Art and education experts explain on how art can be integrated into education with onset of changes brought about by the NEP 2020. They also discuss the benefits of art becoming a main stream form of education.



Warli is one of the oldest form of Indian folk art and has its origin in the Warli region of Maharashtra.



This form of the tribal art mainly makes use of geometrical shapes such as circles, triangles and squares to form numerous shapes depicting life and belief of the Warli tribe. These shapes are symbolic of different elements of Nature.

This great Warli folk painting is a form of tribal art mainly created by tribal people in the northern region of the Sahyadri Range, which comprises cities like Jawahar, Palghar and Vikramgharh districts in India.



The name Warli Art is derived from the word "Warli" which means "piece of land".



Their art depicts the life, beliefs, social customs and traditions of the "Warli or Varli's"... an Adivasi tribe living around the Maharashtra Gujarat border.



As a part of the trust on Experiential learning, Warli Art will be used as an art integrated learning method in classroom transaction not only for creating joyful classroom but also for imbibing the Indian ethos through integration of Indian art and culture in the teaching and learning process at early level.

Here I am making an attempt to explain how Warli Art will be useful to follow the guidelines of Central Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan.


Transformation: Transformative education is set to become to hallmark of student life in India thanks to the application of Indian ethos to education.


Many skills will be developed among children by introducing various themes in Warli Art.


Sense of Service: This is also an important way of staying true to our roots, especially in today's climate that calls for greater environmental and human rights based good.

Warli Art is such an useful art integrated teaching method that we can introduce many things easily.


Co-Location: Higher education would also be in co-location as far as an industry's R&D goes. This would help in more practice-based learning.
